Same sex marriage is legal under Estonian law as of Jan, 2024

SLOVENIA

The safest country in the region

ROMANIA

The lowest gender pay gap in the region and EU

AUSTRIA/LATVIA/ ESTONIA

Female workers work 1 day in a week for free compared to their male colleagues

(~20% gender pay gap)



Mental health


European region suffers from the **highest rate of mental disorders** in the world


