The trucking industry faces many headwinds, including the financial pressures of higher commercial auto jury awards, organized fraud rings, higher retentions, increased premiums, and limited capacity from insurance companies.

Lockton has been involved with various industry groups at national, state, and local levels ever since we began servicing the transportation industry over 30 years ago. We are members of the ATA Legal Reform Advisory Committee with a mission to support state-specific legislative reforms and initiatives that battle the legal forces attacking the industry. We are also active members and participants of the

TCA, NTTCA, TIDA, and claims/defense organizations such as ALFA, US Law, and the American College of Transportation Attorneys. Lockton also actively supports the Council of Insurance Agents and Brokers, the main lobbying group for the insurance industry in Washington, who continues the fight against litigation abuse. We also have our own Lockton PAC, which supports federal and state tort reform issues, and we have several senior government relations Associates who are closely involved at the federal and state legislative level.

We believe the key to meaningful lawsuit/tort reform in the industry is state-specific and revolves around key strategic victories around areas like litigation funding, caps on noneconomic damages, elimination of seat belt gag rules, and other similar issues. We will continue to support all industry groups and efforts to help curb litigation abuse and nuclear verdicts.
